## Building a Home for a Family in Need

On February 11 through February 15, teens, parents, and young adults from St. Bernadette parish will go on mission to Puerto Penasco, Mexico (Rocky Point) to build a home for a needy family in four days. Our missionaries will live in conditions similar to those of the family that they will be serving. They will have no electricity or running water, sleep outside in tents, and only receive 2 gallons of water per person for bucket showers each day. You can be apart of this amazing experience too. Here are some ways to get involved:

**Prayer** – You can pray for our family in Mexico and for the missionaries that are attending.

**Financial Donation** – This can be done by bringing in either cash or a check made out to St. Bernadette Catholic Church with “Mexico Mission” in the memo to the parish office.
